Paracelsus believed that the cosmos was fashioned from three spiritual substances: the *tria prima* of Mercury, Sulfur, and Salt. These are not the substances we recognize today, but rather broad principles that give every object both its inner essence and outer form. Mercury is the transformative agent, Salt is the solidifying/substantiating agent, and Sulfur is the activating agent that leads substance to transformation.

In this workshop, Lara and Jeff will present the experience of the tria prima, mercury-sulfur-salt, as it relates to the alchemical/transformative dimension of life. We will discuss and work with these principles as they manifest in our dreams and our every-day life experiences. This workshop is for individuals who have experience with alchemical concepts, as well as those for whom this is totally new material.

Jeffrey Kiehl, PhD, is a senior Jungian Analyst, training analyst for the C.G. Jung Institute of Colorado and the Inter-Regional Society of Jungian Analysts. Jeffrey has held faculty positions at various universities for over forty years. He has published articles on *US Cultural Complexes and Climate Change*, *The Green Man*, and *The Nature of Uncertainty/The Uncertainty of Nature*. Jeffrey has lectured on psyche & matter, synchronicity, and alchemy.
